In recent years, his research has been concentrated around one of the critical challenges of the 21st century: sustainable industrial change. One line of this research focuses on how socio-economic trends are driving change and innovation in crucial industries in Møre og Romsdal, like the marine-, maritime- and tourism industry. Another line of this research focuses on policy implementation, especially R&D policy, and its connection with industrial change income.
